**Responsibilities include:**

- Collaborate with providers in long-term care health care settings
- Assists in the timely development, implementation and evaluation of directed plan of correction, directed in-services and related referrals under the remediation contract.
- Day to day operational management of a nursing facility if remediation requires
- Provides the presentation of the curriculum for directed in-service trainings on clinical topics specified in the MOU.
- Actively develop a workable plan of correction with facility staff utilizing the guidelines in the SOM
- Overnight and travel to Nursing Homes for site visits and presentations

- 3 years Nursing Home Administrator with current licensure and experience required, preferably as a Director of Nursing
- Knowledge of quality improvement methodology
- Must have effective communication skills including public speaking and be comfortable with presentations to groups.
